Our Reference: End of Term Update

Dear Parent/Carer,

I would like to start by thanking you for your support during this term. There have been many things to celebrate, particularly individual student's achievement.

You will receive a copy of your child's Autumn Term Report in the post. These are also shared with the student's home schools, so they can see the progress that your child is making in school.

Following the change in the length of time that is now required in isolation following being a 'close contact' of a positive case, school has partially reopened today:

Tuesday – Year 11 & 12 in School | Year 9 & 10 Remote Learning

Wednesday – Year 11 & 12 in School | Year 9 & 10 Remote Learning

Thursday – Year 9 & 10 in School | Year 11 & 12 Remote Learning

Friday – School closed for all year groups for INSET

On Thursday 17 December, students will be dismissed at 12.30pm. 'Re-do and Booster' sessions will run as normal; we want all students to end the term positively. Students will have Reward Lunch at 12.00pm on Thursday, as we are restricted in the end of term activities we can offer this year.

To acknowledge the excellent standard of uniform over the last half term, as an end of term treat, students can wear non-school uniform on Wednesday/Thursday (depending on their day in school) with no charge. It is important that students wear sensible clothes (no ripped jeans, shorts, crop tops or hats). Hair must not be dyed and facial piercings cannot be worn.

We would encourage the students to wear their Christmas Jumpers, as school was closed when we would have supported this national event, last week.

Students in school on Wednesday will have their Christmas Lunch as part of their end of term reward. Please look out for pictures on Twitter @LadderSchool.

Contact us via e-mail covidalert@tls.merciantrust.org and we will have staff on duty at 10.00am daily to respond to your e-mail.


As always, our priority is the wellbeing of our students and staff. We have all been affected, one way, or another, in this pandemic and we really do not want families to suffer, or be disrupted further over this festive period. With this in mind, and to avoid cases in the final week of term, may I remind you to keep your child at home if they, or anyone in their household, displays any of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

- a high temperature: any new high temperature where your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back
- a new continuous cough: coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste: a noticeable loss of smell or taste or things smell and taste different to normal.
